



## Extracurricular “Roster” Fees

2016-17 School Year

Students participating in extracurricular activities during the 2016-17 school year will be assessed a “roster” fee. The fee will assist the school district in partially offsetting the costs of sponsoring the programs. The “roster” fee does not replace traditional team/club fundraising nor does it replace traditional club/team items that are purchased by the student/parent (special team hats, shoes, costumes, etc). The “roster” fee does not guarantee the student playing time or any other automatic eligibility.

Fees:

Athletic Participation:	\$75.00/per sport
Activity Participation:	\$25.00/per activity
<b>Maximum fee per student</b>	<b>\$150.00</b>

Students will be assessed a “roster” fee in the following manner:

Student-athletes and students on competitive activity teams must submit their “roster” fees by the end of their season in order to participate on another athletic or competitive team. For example, a football player or a mathlete member will not be able to participate on a winter or spring team until their fall fee is paid.

Students in non-competitive activities (Visual Arts Club, National Honor Society, etc.) will be assessed the “roster” fee if they have established themselves as a club member by September 30<sup>th</sup>. Students who join non-competitive activities after September 30<sup>th</sup> will be assessed the “roster” fee upon joining the club.

Coaches and sponsors will submit their rosters in a timely manner to allow the Business Office to update the student’s fee record in Skyward. Students/parents can pay the fee by credit card via Skyward Family Access or by cash/check in the Business Office.

No “roster” fees will be refunded. This includes but is not limited to students who quit the extracurricular team/club, become ineligible for academic and non-academic reasons, and are removed from the team/club by the coach/sponsor.

“Roster” fees from prior years must be paid in full to be eligible for participation in the 2016-17 school year. Students who fail to pay their “roster” fees may be ineligible to participate in the driver education program, special events such as prom, and/or the following season’s extracurricular programs.
