



SUMMER SCHOOL EXPECTATIONS

OAK LAWN COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL

1. Students must be in their classroom and in their seats by 8:00 a.m. Students also need to arrive back to class on time after the scheduled breaks.
2. Students are not allowed to smoke on the grounds or in the building.
3. Students should not arrive more than fifteen (15) minutes before the start of class and should leave the grounds at once after class is dismissed for the day.
4. Students who drive must park in the designated student parking lot on Austin Avenue.
5. Students are not permitted to roam the hallways or be in non-designated summer school areas.
6. Students will not be allowed to leave the building during breaks. Students are only permitted to use the Student Cafeteria or the designated break area before school or during the fifteen-minute break. During the five-minute breaks, students are expected to stay in the hallway near their classrooms. During the fifteen-minute break, students are expected to remain in Student Cafeteria or the designated break area until they are released.
7. The Student and Parent Handbook will serve as a guide for summer school; however, disciplinary actions will be modified to accommodate summer school. Students who repeatedly violate school rules will be dropped from summer school.
8. Daily attendance is mandatory! A student who is absent more than one day will be withdrawn from the course and issued a failing grade.

Failure to comply with the above expectations will result in dismissal from summer school and loss of credit.
