



Frequently Asked Questions for Apprentice Applicants

WHAT IS THE OAK LAWN APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM?

The program is a career-development opportunity that places apprentice applicants in full-time trade positions with local Oak Lawn businesses. The goals of the program are to provide you with an opportunity to earn a wage and learn transferrable job skills while gaining valuable work experience. In some cases, long-term employment may follow the successful completion of an apprenticeship.

HOW DO I APPLY FOR THE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM?

Apply through your high school or community college career development office, which will have Oak Lawn Apprenticeship Program applications available.

WHAT IS THE APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR THE APPRENTICESHIP?

Applications are taken and apprenticeship positions are filled on a rolling basis as long as there are host businesses that are hiring. Applications will be valid for a period of six months and during this time, you need not reapply each time a new host business announces their participation in the program. They will already automatically receive the ongoing file of valid applications.
